



Hello winter campers!

Winter camp is this weekend and this is the kit list and the joining instructions that you need...

Where?	Beamish Museum, Beamish, County Durham, DH9 0RG
When?	Saturday 10th March at 10am to Sunday 11th March 10:15
Really where?	Meet us in the car park with your overnight gear so we can store it in the car during the day. We will return the scouts to the same place.
Do I need uniform?	No, you don't because you'll have a coat on all day and we'd never see it, however you should still dress for a day outdoors
How do I dress for a day outdoors?	No jeans. I'd strongly suggest you dress like you're going for a walk on a cold day. Hiking boots are recommended. We will be playing familiar scout wide games in the dark after the museum has closed and you won't be allowed to join in if you are wearing your best trainers. Wellies are a bad idea. The weather forecast is currently rain. Waterproofs are essential. This includes trousers if you have them.
What do I need during the day?	A small day sack that you can carry round with you containing: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- A packed lunch- A water bottle with water in it- Room for your waterproofs if the weather gets out nice and you don't have to wear them- A small amount of money (absolutely no more than £5) in case you fancy a trip to the bakery or sweet shop.
What should be in my overnight kit?	As a bare minimum: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Sleeping mat- Sleeping bag- Pillow- Pyjamas- Wash kit- Change of underwear- Some indoor shoes- A change of clothes in case we get really rained on during the day- Some plastic bags for wet kit
What will we provide?	During the course of the day you will get: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- An activity in 2 parts- Time to have lunch!- Some free time to explore- Fish and chips for dinner- Hot chocolate in the tea rooms- Games outside in the dark- Room to sleep on the floor of the Masonic Hall- Breakfast in the tea rooms
